
[Multifactorial intervention in patients with type 2 diabetes

- how much can be gained and how low should we go?]

The importance of intensified multifactorial intervention targeting hyperglycemia, hypertension, dyslipidemia, and microalbuminuria in patients with type 2 diabetes in reducing the risk for mortality, cardiovascular and microvascular disease has beyond doubt been demonstrated in the Steno-2 study.

However, the role of intensified glucose lowering has been challenged in the ACCORD trial stopping the glucose arm prematurely due to excess mortality with intensive therapy.

Also, the blood pressure and lipid studies from ACCORD have been published with no significant impact on cardiovascular disease of intensified blood pressure lowering treatment, and no extra benefits of adding a fibrate to statin treatment.
